

When should I refer to CDC?

Developmental Problems Ages 0 – 6	
Refer when	Referral information needed
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Significant caregiver/parent concern about child's development • Developmental concerns from other agencies involved with child • Developmental progression delayed or uneven <p>May include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gross and fine motor delays - significant language delay - unusual repetitive behaviours - poor social responsiveness <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspect associated medical conditions • Established disability, needing to access specialist CDC services such as OT, Splinting, Orthopaedic, Feeding and Soiling clinics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demographic data • Birth, developmental and medical history • Family and social history • Copies of previous of mental health, language, cognitive and audiology assessments • Early intervention: recommended/delivered • Response to early intervention • Hearing and vision screen

When should I refer to CDC?

Developmental Problems Ages 6 - 15	
Referral when	Data needed
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Significant parent/caregiver concern and concern from other agencies involved • Significant language delay • Significant communication problems • Unusual repetitive behaviours • Poor social responsiveness • Attention/concentration/behaviour problems in conjunction with significant learning problems • Delays in two or more areas of functioning eg academic, social, daily living • Established disability, needing to access specialist CDC services such as OT, Splinting, Orthopaedic, Feeding and Soiling clinics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demographic data • Developmental and medical history • Family and social history • School history • Vision and auditory screen • Copies of previous assessment reports eg medical, language, cognitive, mental health, audiology • Intervention/treatments: recommended and delivered • Response to intervention
